Membership is open to all members of the health professions and anyone with an interest in medical history. Meetings: AMHS meets on the first Thursday of each month from March to November at the Ernest and Marion Davis Medical Library (EMDL) and Lecture Theatre in the grounds of Auckland City Hospital.
