The Auckland Medical History Society (AMHS) was established in 1964 "to promote an interest in and knowledge of medical history, and encourage presentation of medical historical archives and artefacts." Membership is open to all members of the health professions and anyone with an interest in medical history. Guests and new members are welcome, and members are encouraged to invite their friends to the meetings.

Meetings: AMHS meets on the first Thursday of each month from March to November at the Ernest and Marion Davis Library (EMDL) and Lecture Theatre in the grounds of Auckland City Hospital. A programme and confirmation of each meeting date is distributed to members in advance. The meetings follow the format of 6pm refreshments, 6.30pm dinner and one or two presentations from 7.30-9pm. Members and non-members may attend the presentations only. There is no charge for this.

Monthly dinners: For those people who choose to attend the dinner before each meeting, it is important to book ahead of time, for catering purposes. Booking information is included in each 'notice of meeting' that is sent to members in advance.

Reference material: There are displays of historical items in the library. Books from the library's collection may be borrowed by members.
